Golf Places 4th at NCCGA Tournament

UNH Golf placed 4th out of 13 teams at the NCCGA National tournament, hosted in Sea Island, GA (home of the annual PGA's McGladrey Classic) during the weekend of November 17th and 18th, 2012. Troy Goliber, Danny Kish, Colin Barnea, Sam Fuller, CJ Konkowski, James Miller, Greg Poggi, and Tyler Walsh traveled to GA to represent UNH Golf in the first nationals event in the history of UNH Club Golf. The team combined to shoot 402 on the first day of play at the Retreat Course (4th place), and managed to cut total scores down to 391 on the much tougher Seaside Course on the final round of play, leaving them 5 shots behind 3rd place Virginia. East Carolina University placed first, while the University of North Carolina placed second. For individual results: CJ Konkowski placed T-3rd out of more than 100 players for the combined 2 days, by shooting a 78 at the Retreat course, and firing a 73 at the Seaside course on the final day. Troy Goliber also broke the top 30 threshold by shooting 81 at the Retreat (first day) and 79 on the second day (Seaside)
