Wildcat baseball win the NECBA Championship!

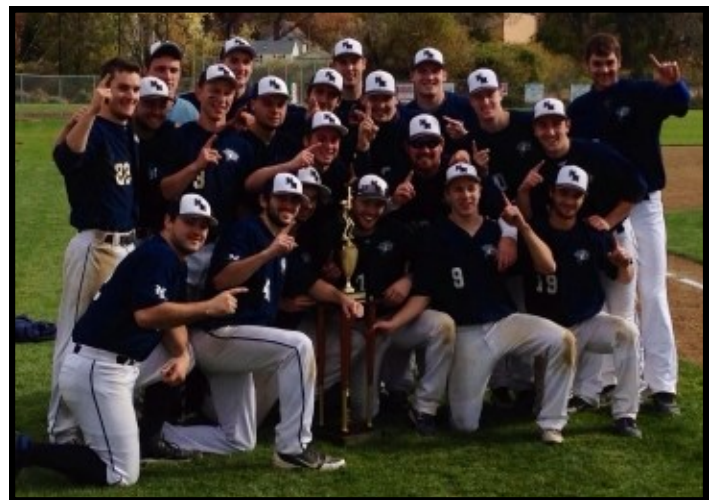
With the 2013 season complete, the wildcats have more than a 20-5 record to be proud of; a league championship reigns superior as highlight to what was an awesome fall season.

Fantastic pitching and solid hitting pushed the wildcats through the season, not to mention their huge margin of victory against opponents. The 'Cats averaged 10.24 runs per game while their pitching and defense only allowed 4.48 runs per game. It is easy to score runs with offensive leaders like Colin Sullivan, Baxter Cohen, Matt Gioia, Dylan Sullivan, Joe Lemenager, Mike White,

Ryan Feeney and Mike Cleary hitting a collective .406 batting average in a total of 473 plate appearances. Pitching was lead by Mike White and Reid Garrity with help from their shutdown closer, Derick MacDowell.

The NECBA Championship semi-final game was a swift victory of 16-5 over Harvard and the championship game pitted UNH against Fairfield with UNH coming out on top in a 4-2 victory and winning the NECBA Championship.

This is UNH's fourth championship in the last 13 seasons and their first since 2005.

Men's Golf travels to Myrtle Beach, SC for their chance to bring a national championship for the fall season back to UNH.

The team will compete in the NCCGA National Championships Saturday and Sunday November 16 and 17 in a two day stroke play event at Barefoot Golf Resort.

The national 12th ranked UNH team will compete against 23 other schools who have also qualified for nationals as well.

This fall, the team went 2-0 in winning regional tournaments and are looking to make some noise now on a national level.
