Baseball & Softball Bring Home Two Championships!

Softball

UNH club softball attended the annual NECA softball tournament hosted at SMCC this year in Portland, ME. UNH advanced past the Seawolves and beat the top seeded NHTI Lady Lynx in a 2-0 shutout for the championship title.

SMCC couldn't compete with UNH's Kate Steinmetz on the mound. Steinmetz allowed 3 hits and delivered 6 strikeouts. UNH had 5 hits and 3 runs against SMCC to end the game with a 3-1 victory.

When UNH took on the Lynx for the championship, UNH senior Megan Gibbons (pictured row 1 on the right) hit a triple that resulted in two RBI's in the first inning. From there scoring ceased, NHTI pitcher answered the 26 batters she faced with 13 strikeouts. However NHTI's offense left 6 players on base with no scoring and UNH walked off with a shutout victory, 2-0.



Baseball

After softball came home with a title, baseball answered with one of their own winning the championship game against the Seawolves of SMCC 9-4.

In the first game of the postseason tournament UNH took on the Eastern Maine CC Golden Eagles. UNH held a 4-0 lead until the 4th inning when the Eagles scored one run and the Wildcats returned with 2. The Eagles tacked on 1 more run in the 7th but couldn't close the 3 run deficit; the Wildcats came out on top 6-3.

The Seawolves of SMCC advanced past the NHTI Lynx 7-1 in the semi-final to position themselves for a shot at the championship.

In the first inning of the championship UNH scored 5 runs and another one in the 2nd to take a big 6-0 lead. The gap remained until the 6th inning when the

Seawolves hit in 2 runs. By the 7th, the Wildcats were up 9-4 to win the title.

More Than a Championship

Baseball coach Miles Roberge hit a perfectly-timed milestone in his coaching career. The championship game earned him his 100th win. His first year with UNH baseball was this year's seniors first year as well. When asked about the championship title Coach Roberge said, "I'm proud of all the players that I have had the privilege to coach. I absolutely love coaching UNH baseball and I love seeing the team be successful even more. The 100th win was meaningful because the seniors are the group of guys who I started out with and I am excited for the success they have had since the beginning. The team has been blessed with talent each year. I feel like Phil Jackson in the 90s, all I have to do is roll a ball onto the field."
